

STUDIO POLICIES

(Please read carefully, retain for your records, and sign registration page to acknowledge you agree)

PAYMENTS:

I understand that payment for classes at Georgia Premier Performance Twirl Dance Cheer, LLC, is payable by cash, check or credit card (Visa, Master Card, or Discover).

Tuition is due on the 1st of the month and late after the 5th. There will be a \$15 fee added to late payments.

A recurring payment by credit card will be processed on the 1st of each month.

Our curriculum is year round and continuous through May. Your enrollment will be ongoing unless a 30 day written notice is given to Georgia Premier Twirl Dance Cheer, LLC, notifying us of your withdrawal. I understand that tuition remains the same regardless of absences and numbers of weeks in the month. Some months will have 3 classes and others 5. Tuition is PER MONTH – NOT PER CLASS.

<u>FAMILY REGISTRATION</u>: I understand there is a one-time per year \$40 PER FAMILY Registration fee. To hold a spot in a class, the registration fee plus the first month's tuition is required.

Camps and Clinics will require full payment at the time of registration for the event. There is no registration fee for camps or clinics.

ATHLETES ONLY ALLOWED IN INSTRUCTION AREA

I understand that parents, siblings, or other family members are not allowed in the instruction area of Georgia Premier Performance Twirl Dance Cheer, LLC, unless otherwise notified by the Premier staff. There is a TV with rolling footage of our classes provided in the lobby area. There is a family restroom near the lobby and that will be the only restroom available to anyone not participating in a class.

No food or drink is allowed in the studio except for water bottles that have lids. Water fountains are provided for those participating in a class.

Students are required to have on the proper attire while in class or they will not be allowed to participate. Flip flops are NOT allowed.

CHARCTER AND CONDUCT

I understand that my family, or anyone associated with my family while at Georgia Premier Performance Twirl Dance Cheer, LLC, will act with good character and display sportsmanship for all athletes. Rude, mean-spirited, and drama-causing behavior will not be tolerated AT ALL. If an issue arises that needs to be discussed, an appointment with the instructor and Candy Byrd-Miller should be made to do so. I fully agree to act with integrity and good character, or immediate dismissal from Premier will be the consequence.

CLASS CHANGE REQUESTS

I understand that if I desire to drop, add, or change a class at any time during the year, written notice must be given. Not showing up for classes does not constitute a withdrawal from class. My account will continue to be charged for tuition until written notice has been given.

BAD WEATHER / HOLIDAYS

Premier will not necessarily close for snow days, regardless if area schools are closed. When in doubt, ask! If classes are cancelled, we will post on social media and <u>www.twirldancecheer.com</u>. We will close for Easter, July 4th, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day. If we close on other holidays, we will notify you.

INSURANCE

Georgia Premier Performance Twirl Dance Cheer, LLC, does not carry insurance for its students. Each student should be covered by their own family insurance policies, and if injury occurs, it is understood the student's own policy is your only source of reimbursement.

STUDIO RULES
